Class Descriptions

Puppy 1 for puppies 9 - 16 weeks, **Puppy 2** for puppies over 16 weeks to 1 year. Instructional lectures are included. Class limit 12.

Beginning: For dogs 5-6 months or older who have never had obedience training or who need a refresher course or who want to participate just for the fun of it. Class limit 12.

Advanced Beginning: For dogs who have completed beginning class, this class concentrates on fun & motivation, communication & increasing basic skills & provides students & their dogs the opportunity to earn the American Kennel Club's Canine Good Citizen award. Class limit 12.

Beyond Advanced Beginning: For dogs who have passed the AKC Good Citizen test. Handlers must be able to control their dogs off leash. Helps handlers improve skills/relationships with their dogs, hone obedience exercises. Weekly fun & games and introduction to canine sports (i.e., competition & rally obedience, agility skills & tricks.) Class limit 12.

Beginning /Advanced Clicker: Both classes employ all positive methods with an emphasis on marking correct behaviors with the clicker (provided) and/or voice marker. The main goal is to either teach (Beginning) or refine (Advanced) the fun, effective clicker training method that encourages a "thinking" dog that loves to learn. Class limit 8/6.

Competitive Obedience : The following classes are designed to teach the handler & dog the skills necessary to enter the obedience show ring. The first 3 classes are for teams working to earn the Novice Obedience title. Each class is limited to 12 unless otherwise stated.

Fundamentals: Introductory for beginning dogs not yet ready for Skill Building to establish a minimum set of skills: sit, down , straight line heeling, attention & positioning, concepts of bonding & teamwork.

Skill Building: Builds on Fundamentals & teaches various required moves in novice (turns, change of pace, stationary exercises, recall [front finish] & stand for exam.

Adv. Skill Building: Hones/polishes exercises learned in Skill Building; introduces retrieve. Class limit 6.

Ring Ready: For dog/handler teams, who know all the individual moves but need practice in stringing them together; covers AKC rules, ring management & performance/warm-up strategies.

Open or Utility Training to prepare the teams to pass AKC, CKC or UKC open or utility routines. Dogs must be able to retrieve. Class limit 12/ 6. **Open & Utility Skill Building** prefer dogs without a CDX or UD limit 8

Rally Obedience: For those who have successfully completed beginning and/or adv. beginning classes, this new form of competition includes elements of both traditional obedience and agility. Rally allows handlers to talk, praise and encourage their dogs. It is a regular competition class in AKC, CKC and UKC.

AGREEMENT
